



## APPLYING THROUGH YOUR UNIVERSITY

### 1. Apply to study abroad at your university

Your university requires you to apply first to the study abroad office on campus and gain acceptance before submitting an online application profile to AHA. Contact the study abroad office on your campus to obtain further instructions on how to apply for an AHA program.

### 2. Create a profile in the AHA online system

After you have been accepted by your home campus, the first step in the AHA process is to create an online profile using the AHA online application system. Go to the program page for the location you have been accepted for, and click the “apply now” button. You will be prompted to fill out your personal details and create a log-in account. Then, you can select the term. If you have been accepted for more than one program or term, select the “apply now” button again, and follow the prompts to select your second term.

The AHA online system is where you will access important information throughout the process of studying abroad.

### 3. Read university-specific application instructions

Once you have created a profile and logged in, please read the Application Instructions page for further details to complete your application. Campus processes vary, so it is important to pay close attention to the details listed on the Application Instructions page.
